

Kids to Camp Grant Application Form

Established in 2004, the Waterloo Region Record-Lyle S. Hallman Foundation Kids to Camp Fund annually provides grants to local charities and non-profits for the purpose of enabling children and youth in need of financial assistance to attend a variety of overnight, recreational and educational camps.

What you need to know before starting your grant application!

Save and Resume feature - Similar to our Kids to Camp Grant Evaluation report, your input on the grant application is automatically saved in your browser for four (4) weeks. Make sure your browser's settings for online forms are set to Enable Autofill.

Please remember to use the same device, and the same web browser (i.e. Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, etc.) each time you wish to work and continue on your application.

You will need your Camp program budget, a camp brochure or a detailed description and your organization's most recent annual financial statement. You will be asked to attach these electronically to your application.

We'll be asking you about the number of day/residential campers from age groups 12 & Under and 13-17 years old estimated to benefit from the grant. As a returning applicant, please be ready to provide us the year(s) you have been receiving the Kids to Camp grant.

Having a copy of last year's Kids to Camp application will be of great help as well. If you wish to request a copy of your grant application last year, please send us a quick e-mail at admin@cndcf.org.

Organizations can submit multiple applications for different camps. Please ensure to submit one application per camp.

Get approval from your boss. It's one thing if YOU think it is a really good idea, and a totally different thing to have your team on board.

If your application is approved, we will ask you to recognize the contributions of the Lyle S. Hallman Foundation - Waterloo Region Record

Kids to Camp Fund held at the Cambridge & North Dumfries Community Foundation in your camp or organization literature. These funds make it all possible. We will want to hear how it all goes. It's the stories that make it all real. Send us photos (with permission of course), testimonials, tweets and facebook messages that highlight the Kids to Camp Program.

If your application is successful, you will be required to submit an evaluation report once your camp has concluded.
